If you are you already a reflexology practitioner who has met the professional standards of an RABC recognized Association, and you have provided the required documentation, then you will not be required to take the RABC Proficiency Examinations and you may apply for Approved Reflexology Practitioner Membership with RABC.

Required Documentation

- a) RABC New Membership Application;
- b) Read, sign and date the document called: Code of Ethics & Conduct;
- c) A copy of Professional Reflexology Certificate;
- d) RABC Website Directory Application;
- e) Applications and Documents are located under *Applications & Forms* under the tab *Membership*
- f) Once completed, email to enquiry@reflexologyofbc.com
- g) Please email completed applications, documents, certificate in a PDF format and not as a photo image. Office supply stores offer scanning services
- h) Pay Approved Reflexology Practitioner Membership Fee, see *Payment & Fees* under tab *Membership*
- i) To maintain Approved Reflexology Practitioner membership status in good standing, your Approved Reflexology Practitioner Membership Fee is due each year in January, and you are required to submit at the end of every three years your Continuing Education Credits.
